The TLI grant promotes and supports student centered learning initiatives to enhance new or existing courses. The TLI grant can encompass, but is not limited to the following areas:

- Course Delivery & Communication (face-to-face, hybrid/blended learning, fully online)
- Course Activities & Resources (project, problem, case studies, interactive digital learning materials, tutorials, simulations, multimedia, games)
- Course Assessment and Evaluation (quizzes, surveys, portfolios)

TLI grant applications will be evaluated on the extent to which the course enhancement promotes student engagement and active learning in the teaching and learning process.

Grant recipients will share their experience with the campus community to promote and foster innovation in teaching and learning. A report will be published on the CLT website as a resource for the campus community.
